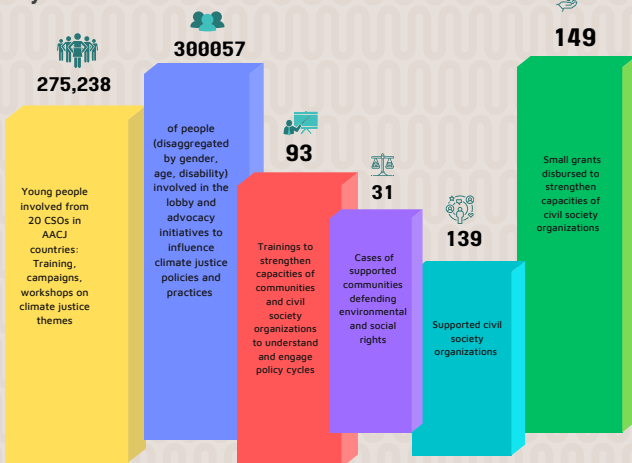
# ABOUT AACJ

The African Activist for Climate Justice (AACJ) is a five-year project funded by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs Strengthening the Climate Justice African Activists movement.

## AACJ 2022 BY THE NUMBERS

The AACJ project implementation From January to December 2022 focused on strengthening civil society partnerships and movements to address the global crisis of climate change.
